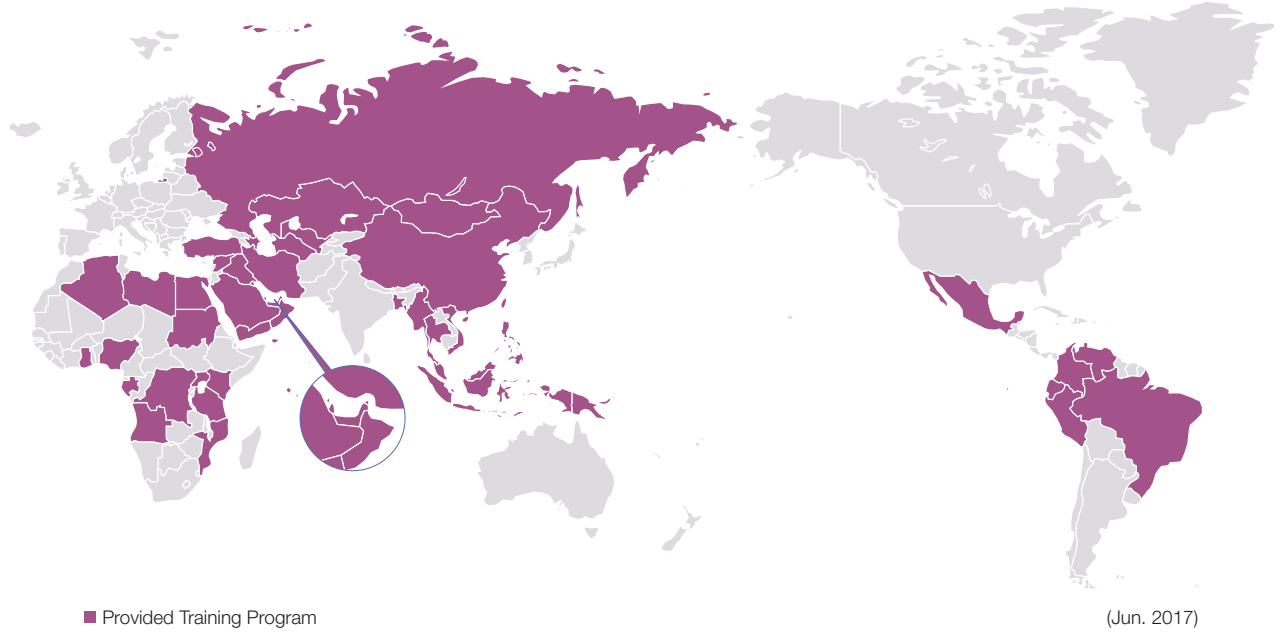


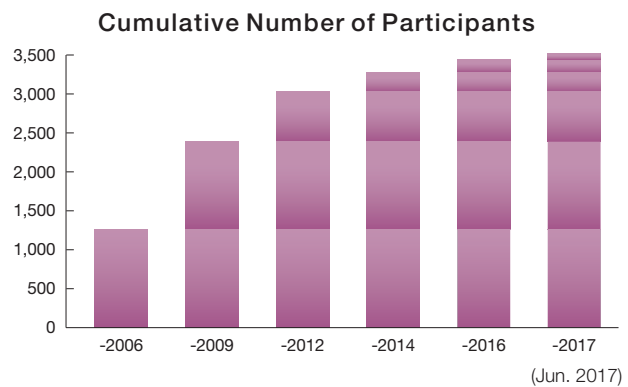


JOGMEC's Relationships with Oil- and Gas-Producing Countries



Training Program for Technical Experts

Since the Training Program started in 1989, over 3,500 internationals from 48 countries have been invited to Japan to participate in the program. JOGMEC also holds alumni meetings to exchange latest information and promote networking. The training program creates opportunities for both participating countries and JOGMEC to foster relationships, share expertise and transfer technology.



Regular Courses

- **Exploration Geology Course** provides skills required for the interpretation and evaluation of geological data. The course combines workshops (practical), and geological excursions.
- **Geophysics Course** provides the skills necessary for oil and gas exploration, teaching practical three-dimensional geophysical exploration techniques. Lectures on current techniques are combined with workshops (training exercises for interpreting and processing geophysical exploration data).
- **Drilling Management Course** provides practical techniques and skills required for well-drilling planning. Lectures on fundamental knowledge and safety management are combined with training exercises using drilling simulators.
- **Reservoir Engineering Course** provides general techniques related to reservoir engineering and management. Lectures on reservoir analysis are conducted in conjunction with workshops (reservoir simulations).

Custom Courses

JOGMEC can design and provide training courses based on requests from oil- and gas-producing countries.

Example

- **LNG Course** was designed to improve technical and managerial skills of engineers and/or managers in the LNG business aspect of the natural gas industry.
